Bylaw No. 3-2004

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STANDARD TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.

Whereas, Section 205 of the Municipal Government Act of the Province of Alberta provides that a municipal council must by Bylaw establish the position of a Chief Administrative Officer.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF STANDARD DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

The position of Chief Administrative Officer for the Municipality of The Village Of Standard be established pursuant to Section 205 of the Municipal Government Act.

The position of Chief Administrative Officer be given the responsibilities pursuant to Section 207 of the Municipal Government Act.

The position of Chief Administrative Officer be given authorities pursuant to Sections 209 and 213 of the Municipal Government Act.

That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon signing.

Bylaw No. 4-95 is hereby rescinded.
