CALL TO ORDER

Mayor M. Gauthier called the Special Council Meeting to order at 7 pm

1. Project Paving 2021

a. Pothole repairs:

Use Project contingency to cover expense for paving of patches of approximately \$3,500.00

b. Waterline Break Rasmussen:

2021-277 Moved by A. Sommerfeldt to pay from Reserves Knibbs Development quote of CARRIED \$9,129.00 to isolate and abandon line not used by any property at the main.

c. Curling Club Paving:

2021-278 Moved by M. Gauthier to pave from sidewalk along Curling Club to the road using Approximately \$10,000.00 from project contingency.

2. Residential Sewer Issues:

Public Utility Bylaw 03-2019 provided for Council to review with the sewer issues.

a. 7th Ave

Home owner A. Tellier provided Plumbers repair ticket noting that sewer issue was on the Village side of his property. Knibbs Development provided quote to homeowner to repair to the main.

b. Rasmussen Place

Letter provided by email from J.Reagan regarding issues with sewer over the last several years, and requesting that the Village sewer line be repaired, and financial assistance to offset the cost of having to Roto-Root yearly.

Village Council reviewed residents concerns and discussed they will review in the future but at this time the Public Utility Bylaw 03-2019 states, "SEWER SERVICE CONNECTION" means the property owner is responsible for the maintenance and repair of the sewer line from the serviced premises to the street sewer main. Therefore any repairs at this time will be at the property-owners expense.

3. Internet MOU / Costs

Provided Council with MOU and Service Contract Agreement for review and comments for possible partnership decision at the November 10th Council meeting.


Provided CRISP funding available and estimate costs for both the Village and Connect Mobility along with a 5 year projection plan.

Design concept being done by Connect Mobility along with Fortis for use of power poles to install radios to transmit the wireless internet signal throughout the Village to residents and businesses.
