

VILLAGE OF STANDARD

BYLAW NO. 450-89

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STANDARD IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE THE AUTHORITY FOR THE SIGNING OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STANDARD MUNICIPAL LIBRARY.

WHEREAS pursuant to section 216 of the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 and all amendments thereto, a Council may acquire land, buildings and facilities for the establishment of ~~an assistance to~~ a library.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Standard in the Province of Alberta is the legal owner of the lands, buildings and facilities known as the Standard Municipal Library located on Lots 1 & 2, Block 9, Plan 2540 AM.

WHEREAS it is considered expedient and proper that there should be an agreement between the Village of Standard and the Standard Municipal Library for the use of the said land, buildings and facilities

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Standard duly assembled does hereby enact as follows:

THAT the Mayor and Municipal Secretary be, and are hereby authorized to sign an Agreement for Use, attached as Schedule "A", between the Village of Standard and the Standard Municipal Library.

This bylaw shall take effect on the date of its final reading.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 7th DAY OF JUNE , 1989.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 5th DAY OF JULY , 1989.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 5th DAY, OF JULY , 1989.
